Arthur Harris told in his autobiography he had not written and signed this message and in fact he only had discovered later that this text was disseminated by his airplanes. The leaflet is illustrated with a drawing of friendly looking Air Marshal Harris and a photograph of a four engine British “Stirling” bombing plane. The drawing of Air Marshal Harris was not shown to Germans during the war on leaflets.

Die Massenschlächtereien in Warschau, Lidice, Charkow und Nanking sind krasse Beispiele dieser Verbrechen, die Tag für Tag, jahraus und jahrein überall begangen werden, wo die Nazis und Japaner ihre Herrschaft aufgerichtet haben.

Notes: The British government disseminated not only “official” leaflets evidently originating from the enemy of the addressee but others used some form of camouflage to hide its publisher. These camouflaged leaflets are commonly called “black” leaflets. Such leaflets are pretending or suggesting to be published not by the British authorities but rather by some other organisation or even by private persons. The reason for such “odd” actions is to avoid confrontation with the reader in the enemy camp. The way camouflage is used varies considerably. Some of these “black” leaflets produced and disseminated by the British government and addressed to Germans are offered below.

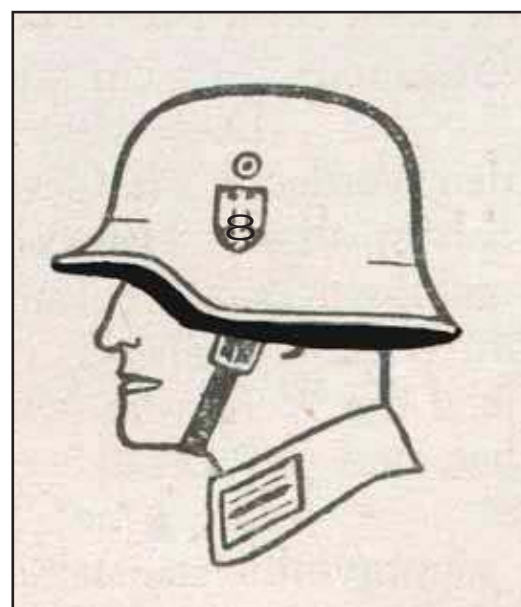
